

HOW TO SET UP AND USE Bevcomm TV on an Apple Device

My Bevcomm TV:

Using Your Apple Remote:

- Click **UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT** on the Touchpad to navigate.
- Press the **Touchpad (center click)** to **SELECT**.
- Press **MENU** (or **BACK**, depending on your remote model) to return to the previous screen.
- Press **TV/HOME** button to return to the Apple TV home screen.

Setting Up Your Apple Device:

1. Connect the Apple TV device to your TV's **HDMI port** and plug in the power cable.
2. Turn on your TV and select the correct HDMI input.
3. Pair the remote and follow on-screen instructions to connect to Wi-Fi and sign in with your Apple ID.
4. Complete any system updates when prompted.

Adding Bevcomm TV to Your Apple Device:

1. On the home screen, open the **App Store**.
2. Navigate to **Search**.
3. Type **Bevcomm TV** or use **Voice Search (Siri button)**.
4. Select the **Bevcomm TV** app.
5. Choose **Get** (or the cloud icon) to download the app.

Accessing Bevcomm TV on Your Apple Device:

1. On the Apple TV home screen, find and highlight **Bevcomm TV**.
2. Click the Touchpad to open the app.
3. On first launch, you'll need to enter your Initial Login and Passphrase. (Contact our office if you haven't received these.)

Watching Bevcomm TV

Accessing the Program Guide:

- From the Bevcomm TV home screen, highlight Live TV or Guide.
- While watching a program, press **MENU/BACK** to open the guide.

Navigating in the Program Guide and Watching a Channel:

- Click **UP/DOWN** to scroll through channels.
- Press the Touchpad to **Watch** the highlighted program.
- Press again for details (Watch, Record, Search, Restart).
- Press the Touchpad 2x to pull up channel number.
- Press **MENU/BACK** inside the guide to open the **Tab Bar** (For You, Guide, Recordings, Search, Settings).

Channel Surfing:

- While watching TV, press arrow keys **UP/DOWN** to jump to the next/previous channel.

Restart Program from Beginning:

- Click **LEFT/RIGHT** during a program to open Info/Video Options.
- Select **Restart Program**, press the Touchpad. (Note: Some programs may not support Restart.)

Rewind, Fast Forward, or Pause Live TV:

- Click **LEFT/RIGHT** on Touchpad to rewind/fast-forward.
- Press **PLAY/PAUSE** to pause or resume live TV.

Quick Guide:

- Swipe **DOWN** while watching to open a list of recently watched channels.
- Scroll **LEFT/RIGHT** to scroll through previous channels.
- Press the Touchpad to switch channels.

Closed Captioning:

- While watching, press **LEFT/RIGHT** to open the Info/Video Options panel.
- Navigate to **CC**, toggle captions ON/OFF.

Recordings

Making a Recording:

- In the guide, select show, and choose **Record** by pressing the Touchpad on one of the following:
 - Series - New Only**
 - Series - All**
 - One-Time**
- If watching program, press **LEFT/RIGHT** to bring up Video Options and select **RECORD**.

Accessing and Managing Recordings:

- Go to the **Tab Bar**, then **Recordings**. Categories include:
 - Current Recordings**: Watch/delete recordings.
 - Future/Upcoming Recordings**: Adjust start/stop times.
 - Series Rules**: Manage episode limits, new/all episodes, and recording times.
 - Recently Deleted**: Restore deleted recordings.
- Swipe or use arrow keys to switch between categories.

Search

Accessing the Search Feature:

- Go to **Tab Bar** and press **Search**.
- Type the name of a program or use **Siri Voice Input**.
- Highlight a program and press the Touchpad.
- Choose **Watch** if it's airing, or **Record** to schedule it.

Settings

Adding a New Device (Up to 20 allowed):

- Go to the **Settings** option in the **Tab Bar**, scroll to **Devices** and press **+**.
- A new login and passphrase will be generated.
- Use these credentials on the device by following the **Accessing Bevcomm TV** steps above.
- In settings, rename your device to identify which room/device Bevcomm TV has been installed on.
